CHROMATIC SCALE

The Chromatic Scale is to be performed as written below, slurred ascending and tongued descending.
The chromatic scale must be played in sixteenth notes at the tempo of ♩ = 100.

The chromatic scale is written on two staves. The first staff shows the ascending scale from C4 to C5, and the second staff shows the descending scale from C5 to C4. The notes are slurred together, and the descending part is marked with a 't' for tongue.

MAJOR SCALES

Major Scales are to be performed in the pattern below with the MM: ♩ = 88.
Woodwinds and Brass are to slur up and tongue down the scale.

Seven major scales are shown, each on a separate staff. The scales are: C major, G major, D major, A major, F major, Bb major, and Eb major.
