

**Massachusetts Music Educators Association
Eastern District Senior Scholarships 2012**

**2012 MMEA-ED Scholarship Application Form
(complete application form is online at mmeaeasterndistrict.org)**

The MMEA Eastern District has established four \$1,000 scholarships to be awarded to four graduating seniors who plan to major in music at an accredited four-year college music program beginning in the Fall 2012. The application deadline is Feb. 28, 2012. An awards committee will review applications in March and the winners will be notified in the spring. Winners will also be acknowledged in the 2013 Sr. District Festival program and announced at the concert.

Eligibility

- A. The applicant must be a graduating senior and be accepted as a music major (Music Education, Applied Music, Composition, Music History, Music Theory, Music Therapy, or Music Technology) in an accredited 4-year college music program.
- B. The applicant must be a fully participating member of one of the 2012 Sr. District Ensembles (Band, Chorus, Jazz Ensemble or Orchestra) during their senior year.
- C. Applicants must also be active members of their school music program and show strong academic success in their school.

Application Procedure

All applications are to be **submitted by Feb. 28** and include the following items:

- A. Completed application form
- B. A letter of recommendation from the applicant's school ensemble director
- C. High school transcripts reflecting grades through the first semester of your senior year.

Scholarship recipients will also need to submit a copy of their college acceptance letter as proof of their acceptance before the scholarship check will be issued.
